2009 SAN MATEO COUNTY JUNIOR FAIR BOARD REQUIREMENTS, BENEFITS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The 2009 San Mateo County Fair Board will be made up of 12 total members which may include members of 4-H, FFA, Scouting Groups and/or is simply a resident of San Mateo County. Applications must be received at the Fair Administration Office by April 24, 2009.

REQUIREMENTS

- San Mateo County resident
- 14-19 years of age
- 2.0 GPA during your term
- Willingness to meet all responsibilities listed below

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Mandatory attendance at a minimum of 1 regular meeting of the Fair's Board of Directors.
- Attendance and active participation at the majority of junior fair board meetings
- Participation in 3 projects involving fair promotion (could include ambassadorship to local organizations, parades, trade shows, etc.)
- Participation in a service project related to the fair (could include the fair's scholarship auction or other project identified by fair management)
- Actively involved in at least one committee executing special programs within the fair (could involve livestock or any department, special promotion days, award announcements, sponsor interaction, etc.). This requires a minimum of 20 hours participation during the fair.

BENEFITS

- Fair apparel and giveaways as determined by fair management
- Daily fair admission for board member and 4 complimentary admission tickets for guests
- 1 day carnival wristband
- Letter of recommendation for college and/or related awards
