

# Packing List and General CAL Information

- sleeping bag & pillow (it may get cold, so an extra blanket is suggested)
- warm clothes - dress in layers (rain gear is optional, but may be needed)
- toiletry items (tooth brush, soap, towel, etc.)
- other personal items
- flashlight
- a small bag to carry your belongings. (Bathrooms/showers are in their own compound across the courtyard from the cabins. Be prepared.)

We will have water bottles for you to fill with fresh spring water on site.

- The telephone at Walker Creek Ranch is for emergency use only (415) 491-6000.
- Cell phones do not work at WCR. Please leave your Ipods and other technology in the car when you arrive.
